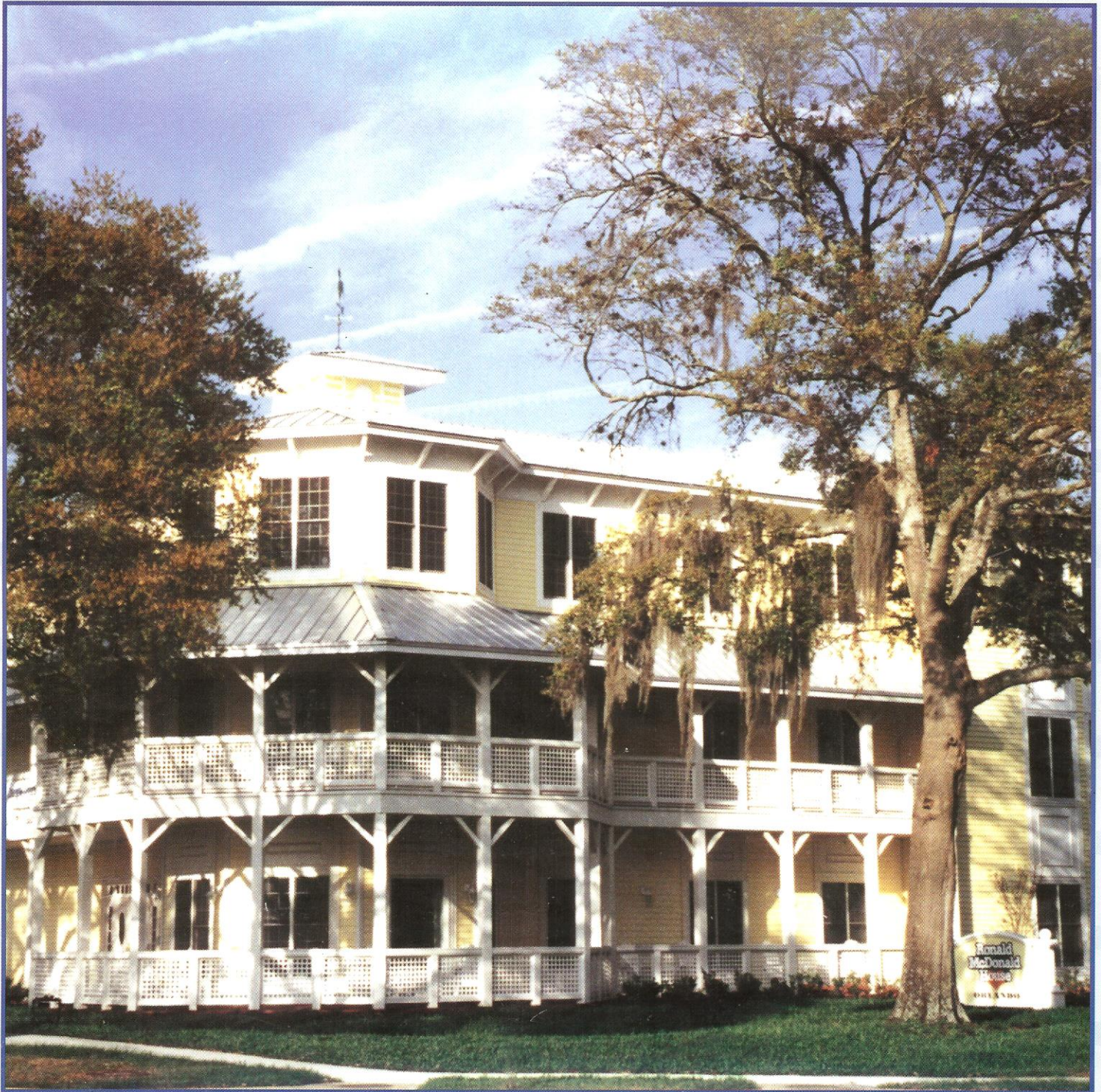

## 1997 VSI AWARDS OF DISTINCTION

For more than 25 years, vinyl siding has been recognized for its performance advantages as well as its cost benefits. According to a recent study, vinyl siding is being used increasingly in residential construction and, in many cases, is becoming the product of choice against competing materials. Whether re-siding a home, restoring a historic building or sprucing up a storefront, contractors, builders, architects and homeowners choose vinyl siding for its aesthetic appeal, ease of installation, low maintenance and time-tested durability.

For the past 14 years the Vinyl Siding Institute (VSI) has recognized outstanding uses of vinyl siding with its industry-wide *Awards of Distinction* program. The competition is designed to highlight vinyl siding's performance qual-

ities in five areas: historic restoration, new construction, residential and non-residential re-siding and special applications. This year's applications were judged by John H. Ingersoll, editor, writer and contributor to many construction, remodeling and home interest magazines; Tom Manion, principal in Lock 9 Architects P.C., a distinguished firm in the Washington, D.C. area noted for its work in historic preservation; and Jerry Y. Huntley, executive director of VSI.

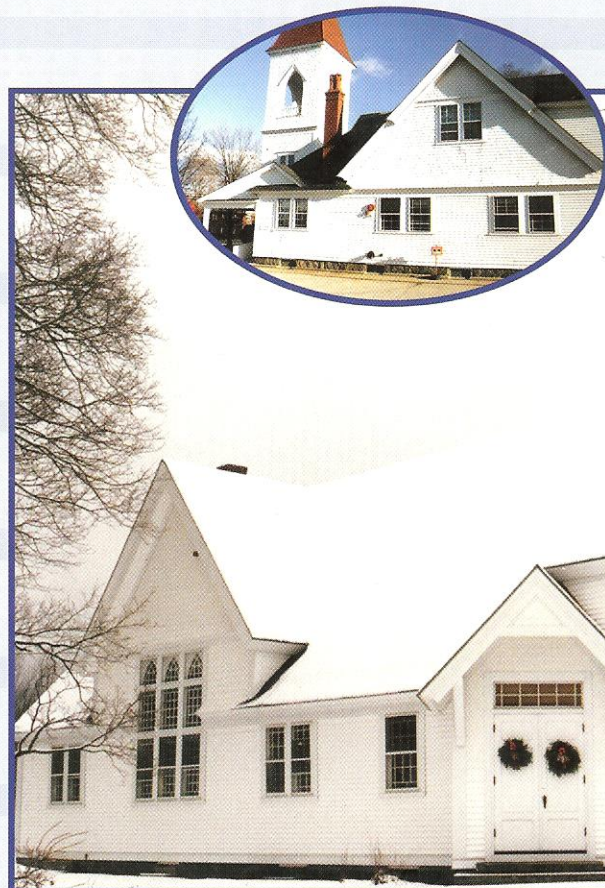
